DOLPHIN ISLAND RESORT

Located off the tip of Viti Levu, if the Duke and Duchess were to stay at **Dolphin Island Resort**, they could be swept away by helicopter to reach the resort.

The beautiful 14-acre retreat offers a superb private 'castaway' experience, where guests can do all the regular things like snorkel and kayak, alongside more boutique Fijian activities, including the kava ceremony, tapa cloth making and traditional dance.

When booking a stay at the resort, if you're a couple or a group, it books out the entire island.
